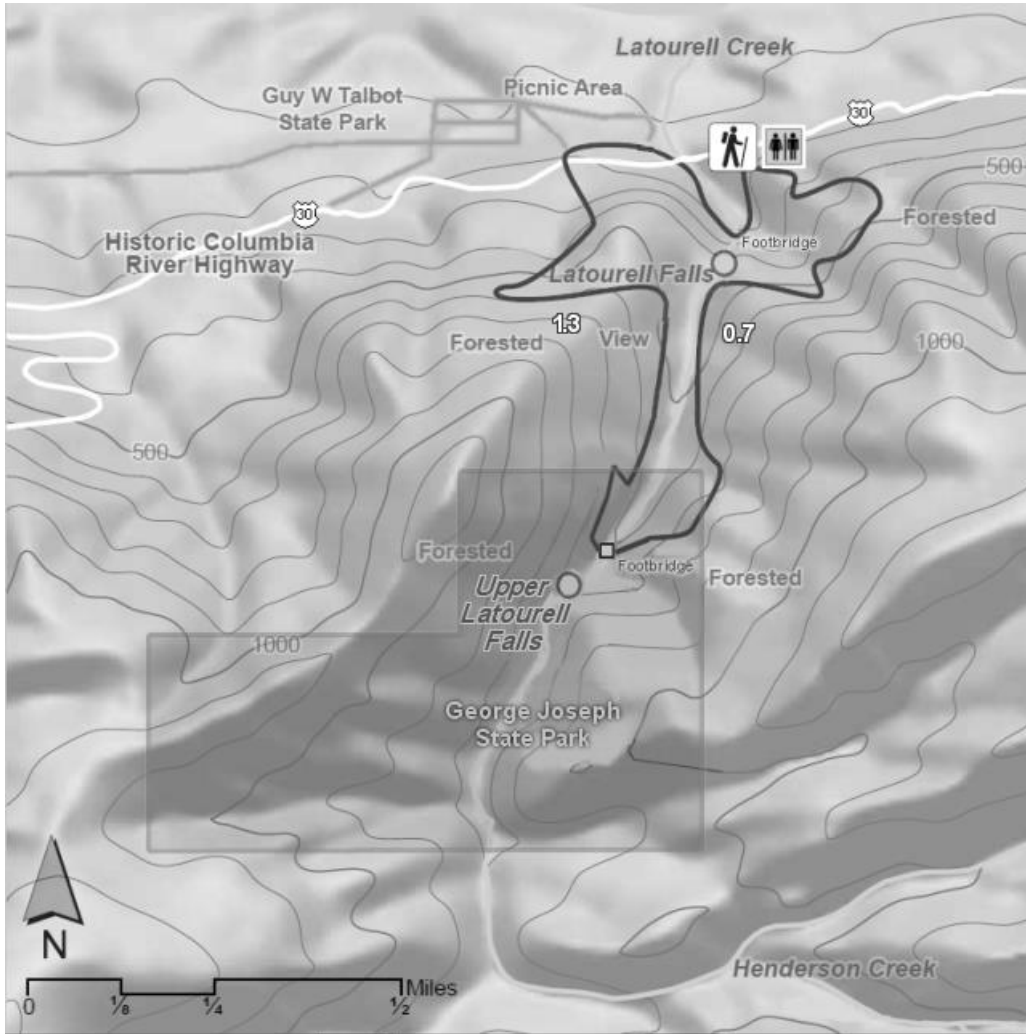


Latourell Falls



Length: 2.15-mile loop

Elevation Gain: 480'

Season: Any time snow free

Permit: Not required

Features: Waterfalls, spring fed creek

This hike is the longest in the Latourell Falls area. You can follow the trail either clockwise or counterclockwise. However you choose to hike this trail, use extreme caution as there are very steep cliffs and drop-offs along the area near the top of the lower falls. The trail meanders through forested areas to a smaller, less imposing waterfall before returning to the parking area. The hike takes you through a picnic area north of the Historic Columbia River Highway.

How to get there:

Traveling east on I-84, take Exit #28 (Bridal Veil). Turn right on the Historic Columbia River Highway at Angel's Rest Trailhead and travel west approximately 3 miles to the parking area on the south side of the road. There are bathroom facilities at this location.

Traveling west on I-84, take Exit #35 (Ainsworth). Drive 11 miles west on the Historic Columbia River Highway to the parking area on the south side of the road. **Make sure to stay left at the Angel's Rest trailhead.**
